It entitles for professional work (for instance, as an engineer, teacher, chemist, etc.), it is also a traditional condition for master and postgraduate programs. Tuition consists of lectures, seminars, workshops, practical classes, practical trainings and internships. Forms of assessment are tests, oral exams and course papers. A State Final Attestation includes also preparing and defense of a Final Graduation Thesis.


Grading scheme, Grade

Students are permitted to be enrolled to the next academic year and to be awarded a degree only in case they have passing grade in all the disciplines included to the curriculum. Not passing grades are: «неудовлетворительно» (unsatisfactory) and «не зачтено» (not passed).
